

CERTIFICATE
Court Facilities Capital Review Board
Cattaraugus County

WHEREAS the Governor of New York signed into law Chapter 825 of the Laws of 1987, known as the Court Facilities Act, on August 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act created the Court Facilities Capital Review Board ("Board") pursuant to Section 1680-c of the Public Authorities Law; and

WHEREAS the Governor of New York has duly appointed the members of the Board pursuant to said section; and

WHEREAS the Board is empowered by said section to review and approve overall plans and cost estimates for the design, acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement, furnishing or equipping of facilities of the courts and court-related agencies of the Unified Court System ("UCS"); and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act, in Judiciary Law section 219, requires each local government in New York to submit such plans, in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts, for review and approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS the Chairman of the Cattaraugus County Legislature previously submitted such a plan in conformance with Judiciary Law section 219 and in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts; and

WHEREAS the courts in Cattaraugus County are located in the County Building at 303 Court Street in Little Valley, which was built in 1967 ("Little Valley building"), and at 1 Leo Moss Drive in Olean, completed in 1990 ("Olean building"); and


WHEREAS due to the growing needs in the Little Valley building, and in light of office space that has become available through relocation of the District Attorney's Office in January 2026, the County proposes to offer an additional 942 square feet of space for court operations; and

WHEREAS on December 30, 2025 the Cattaraugus County Manager submitted a Capital Plan Amendment to the Board providing an additional 942 square feet of office space to UCS on the third floor of the Little Valley building for the Commissioner of Jurors and Chief Clerks; and


WHEREAS the UCS currently occupies 10,209 square feet in the Little Valley building, including 4,584 square feet on the third floor, and the County has offered an additional 942 square feet on the third floor, to increase the total space occupied by UCS in the Little Valley building to 11,151 square feet.

NOW BE IT CERTIFIED that the Court Facilities Capital Review Board has reviewed the Capital Plan amendment and supporting materials submitted by Cattaraugus County, and the Board has determined that the proposed additional square footage for office space and proposed layout will be suitable and sufficient for the transaction of the business of the courts and hereby approves the Capital Plan amendment set forth in this Certificate.
