Court Facilities Capital Review Board
City of Jamestown

WHEREAS the Governor of New York signed into law Chapter 825 of the Laws of 1987, known as the Court Facilities Act, on August 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act created the Court Facilities Capital Review Board ("Board") pursuant to Section 1680-c of the Public Authorities Law; and

WHEREAS the Governor of New York has duly appointed the members of the Board pursuant to said section; and

WHEREAS the Board is empowered by said section to review and approve overall plans and cost estimates for the design, acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement, furnishing or equipping of facilities of the courts and court-related agencies of the Unified Court System ("UCS"); and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act, in Judiciary Law section 219, requires each local government in New York to submit such plans, in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts, for review and approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS the Mayor of the City of Jamestown previously submitted such a plan in conformance with Judiciary Law section 219 and in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts; and

WHEREAS the Jamestown City Court is located on the second floor of Jamestown City Hall at 200 East Third Street, occupying approximately 9,561 square feet; and

WHEREAS the Mayor of the City of Jamestown submitted a Capital Plan Amendment on September 29, 2025 regarding the roof and façade rehabilitation project funded through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and administered by the City's Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS the roof and façade rehabilitation project included full replacement of the roof and structural reinforcement of the exterior façade which commenced in Fall 2024 and was to be completed in Winter 2025; and

WHEREAS the roof and façade rehabilitation project complies with New York State and local building codes, environmental laws and permitting requirements, NYS Court facility Guidelines (22 NYCRR Part 34), UCS and local law enforcement security requirements; and OCA's technology standards; and

WHEREAS the City anticipates future capital improvements to include phase two of the Tracy Plaza Reconstruction to improve public access to the building, security staging, and entry experience for court users and a proposed window replacement project for either partial

replacement or full replacement of windows to improve performance, comfort, and energy efficiency of the building.

NOW BE IT CERTIFIED that the Court Facilities Capital Review Board has reviewed the Capital Plan amendment and supporting materials submitted by the City of Jamestown, and finding the facilities provided by such Capital Plan will be suitable and sufficient for the transaction of the business of the courts and hereby approves the amended Capital Plan, subject to further amendment for the future capital improvements of the Tracy Plaza Reconstruction and proposed window replacement project, as set forth in this Certificate.
