

**CERTIFICATE**  
**Court Facilities Capital Review Board**  
**City of Ogdensburg**

WHEREAS the Governor of New York signed into law Chapter 825 of the Laws of 1987, known as the Court Facilities Act, on August 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act created the Court Facilities Capital Review Board ("Board") pursuant to Section 1680-c of the Public Authorities Law; and

WHEREAS the Governor of New York has duly appointed the members of the Board pursuant to said section; and

WHEREAS the Board is empowered by said section to review and approve overall plans and cost estimates for the design, acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement, furnishing or equipping of facilities of the courts and court-related agencies of the Unified Court System ("UCS"); and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act, in Judiciary Law section 219, requires each local government in New York to submit such plans, in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts, for review and approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS the Mayor of the City of Ogdensburg previously submitted such a plan in conformance with Judiciary Law section 219 and in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts; and

WHEREAS the Ogdensburg City Court is located in the Ogdensburg City Hall at 330 Ford Street; and


WHEREAS the City Manager of the City of Ogdensburg submitted a Capital Plan Amendment on January 30, 2026 regarding the window replacement project to address deteriorated and inefficient windows affecting building performance and comfort and heating & cooling (HVAC) upgrade project to maintain reliable environmental conditions for court operations, staff, and the public, which the City anticipates utilizing municipal capital funding to complete; and


WHEREAS the construction for the window replacement project, including 28 total windows throughout City Hall (including court-occupied areas), is anticipated in 2027 with an estimate of \$240,500 and the construction for the HVAC upgrade project, including replacement/upgrading the heating and cooling system serving court-occupied spaces, is anticipated in 2028 with an estimate of \$65,000; and


WHEREAS the window replacement and HVAC upgrade projects will comply with New York State and local building codes, environmental laws and regulations, NYS Court facility Guidelines (22 NYCRR Part 34), UCS and local law enforcement security requirements; and OCA's technology standards; and

NOW BE IT CERTIFIED that the Court Facilities Capital Review Board has reviewed the Capital Plan amendment and supporting materials submitted by the City of Ogdensburg, and finding the facilities provided by such Capital Plan will be suitable and sufficient for the transaction of the business of the courts and hereby approves the amended Capital Plan, as set forth in this Certificate.
