

**CERTIFICATE**  
**Court Facilities Capital Review Board**  
**Clinton County**

WHEREAS the Governor of New York signed into law Chapter 825 of the Laws of 1987, known as the Court Facilities Act, on August 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act created the Court Facilities Capital Review Board ("Board") pursuant to Section 1680-c of the Public Authorities Law; and

WHEREAS the Governor of New York has duly appointed the members of the Board pursuant to said section; and

WHEREAS the Board is empowered by said section to review and approve overall plans and cost estimates for the design, acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement, furnishing or equipping of facilities of the courts and court-related agencies of the Unified Court System ("UCS"); and

WHEREAS the Court Facilities Act, in Judiciary Law section 219, requires each local government in New York to submit such plans, in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts, for review and approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS the County Administrator of Clinton County previously submitted such a plan in conformance with Judiciary Law section 219 and in the form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Courts; and

WHEREAS the courts in Clinton County are located at 137 Margaret Street and 72 Clinton Street in Plattsburgh; and

WHEREAS due to the growing needs in the building located at 72 Clinton Street, and in light of office space that has become available from the County, the County proposes to offer an additional 968 square feet of space for court operations; and


WHEREAS on April 14, 2026, the Clinton County Administrator submitted a Capital Plan Amendment providing an additional 968 square feet of office space to UCS on the Second Floor at 72 Clinton Street; and

WHEREAS UCS currently occupies 1,232 square feet of space on the Second Floor at 72 Clinton Street and the County has offered an additional 968 square feet on the Second Floor, to increase the total space occupied by UCS on the Second Floor in the building to 2,200 square feet.



suitable and sufficient for the transaction of the business of the courts and hereby approves the Capital Plan amendment set forth in this Certificate.


