Capital Plan Solicitations At-a-Glance

- There are 119 political subdivisions in New York State with court facilities (not including New York City).
- **14 Priority Political Subdivisions**
 - November/December 2024 – UCS letters sent requesting capital plan amendments. These cities/counties had either chronic problems or ongoing/past capital work that needed approval.

- **63 Secondary Political Subdivisions**
 - February/March 2025 – UCS letters sent requesting capital plan amendments to address critical deficiencies.

 - 41 cities and counties are due to respond by May 28, 2025.
